Pursuant to and authorized by the NMLA General Drawing Rules and Procedures approved and adopted by the NMLA Board of Directors on May 4, 2001, the following sections of the SLINGO® 2nd Chance Drawing Rules have been amended:

SECTION 9.0 - WINNER NOTIFICATION

1.0 NAME OF DRAWING: SLINGO®

2.0 TYPE OF DRAWING: 2ND CHANCE PRIZE DRAWING

3.0 PURPOSE OF DRAWING:

To provide players of the New Mexico Lottery Authority's (NMLA) Scratcher game, SLINGO®, Game #636, a chance to win a prize in two (2) 2nd Chance Drawings.

4.0 METHOD:

Two (2) separate 2nd Chance Drawings will be conducted by the NMLA.

4.1 The JANUARY 2010 Drawing

4.1.1 Five (5) ENTRIES will be selected to each win a prize package containing:

4.1.1.1 one (1) "Slingo Quest" Nintendo DS game,

4.1.1.2 one (1) Nintendo DSi™ portable game system,

4.1.1.3 and one (1) Nintendo DSi 18-in-1 starter kit - Includes Charging Dock, Carrying Case, USB SD Card Reader, Car Charger, Earbuds, Audio Splitter, 3 Screen Cleaners, 2 Sets of Screen Protectors, Carry All Tote Bag, 2 Styluses, 3 Game Cases & Wrist Strap.

4.1.2 Ten (10) alternates will be selected.

4.2 The MARCH 2010 Drawing

4.2.1 Five (5) ENTRIES will be selected to each win a prize package containing:

4.2.1.1 one (1) "Slingo Quest" Nintendo DS game,

4.2.1.2 one (1) Nintendo DSi™ portable game system,

4.2.1.3 and one (1) Nintendo DSi 18-in-1 starter kit - Includes Charging Dock, Carrying Case, USB SD Card Reader, Car Charger, Earbuds, Audio Splitter, 3 Screen Cleaners, 2 Sets of Screen Protectors, Carry All Tote Bag, 2 Styluses, 3 Game Cases & Wrist Strap.

4.2.2 Ten (10) alternates will be selected.

5.2.1 ENTRY Deadline:

Friday, January 8, 2010 4:30 PM MT.

5.2.2 Drawing Date:

Tuesday, January 12, 2010

5.2.3 Drawing Time:

Approximately 10:00 AM MT.

5.3 The MARCH 2010 Drawing

5.3.1 ENTRY Deadline:

Friday March 5, 2010 4:30 PM MT.

5.3.2 Drawing date:

Tuesday, March 9, 2010

5.3.3 Drawing Time:

Approximately 10:00 AM MT.

5.4 The NMLA reserves the right to change the location, date and time of the drawing.

6.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR DRAWINGS:

6.1 One (1) non-winning NMLA SLINGO®, Game #636 ticket will constitute one (1) ENTRY.

6.2 Voided tickets do not constitute an ENTRY and are not eligible for this promotion.

6.3 Multiple ENTRIES are allowed, however, players are eligible to win only one (1) prize package for either drawing.

6.4 A ticket may only be submitted as an ENTRY one time.

- 6.5** ENTRIES not selected in the January 2010 Drawing are not eligible for the March 2010 Drawing.
- 6.5.1 ENTRIES received prior to the January 8, 2010 4:30 pm deadline will only be eligible for the January 2010 Drawing.
- 6.5.2 ENTRIES received after the January 8, 2010 4:30 pm deadline will only be eligible for the March 2010 Drawing.
- 6.6** Players must access the NMLA web site at www.nmlottery.com to enter the drawing. The following player information is required:
- 6.6.1 first and last name
- 6.6.2 contact telephone number and/or an address, city, state, and zip code
- 6.6.3 the Game number, Pack number, and Ticket number found on the back of one (1) non-winning NMLA SLINGO®, Game #636
- 6.6.4 player must certify that he/she is at least 18 years old
- 6.6.5 player must certify that he/she is logged in from inside the boundaries of the State of New Mexico for the purpose of submitting ENTRIES for this promotion
- 6.6.6 player must certify that he/she has read and understands the drawing rules
- 6.7** If selected, in order to claim a prize, the original signed ticket must be presented for verification.
- 6.8** Any ENTRY received in the mail or hand delivered will be deemed ineligible and may be discarded at the discretion of the NMLA EVP of Security and Enforcement.
- 6.9** The NMLA is not responsible for any ENTRY not received or received after the deadline due to transmission failure via the Internet, including but not limited to, equipment or communication failure.
- 6.10** The NMLA is not responsible for any ENTRY that is incomplete, that has mis-entered information, or fails to meet ENTRY requirements.
- 6.11** Any ENTRY received not meeting the criteria specified in these rules will be deemed ineligible and disqualified if selected.
- 6.12** An MIS representative will provide the EVP of Security and Enforcement or designee with a list of any duplicate ENTRY attempts, as determined by the EVP of Security and Enforcement and the Director of MIS. An NMLA Security and Enforcement representative or a designee will attempt to contact, via email or phone, the player that attempted to submit the duplicate ENTRY and attempt to resolve the situation.
- 6.13** Players must be 18 years of age or older to purchase a lottery ticket, submit an ENTRY, and/or claim a prize.
- 6.14** ENTRIES must be submitted within the boundaries of the State of New Mexico.
- 6.15** Players need not be present at the drawings to win.
- 6.16** Participants, by submitting an ENTRY for this promotion, are deemed as having satisfied themselves and as having agreed with the rules of this promotion and all rules, policies and procedures contained herein or as applicable.
- 6.17** An ENTRY received pursuant to these rules is deemed a non-winning ticket and will not be checked for winners.
- 6.18** Previously validated tickets are ineligible ENTRIES and will be disqualified if selected.
- 6.19** All ENTRIES received become the property of the NMLA.
- 6.20** To ensure that any ENTRY cannot be submitted more than one time during the course of the promotion, the ENTRIES are retained in the entry data base, regardless of whether or not they are selected in a drawing.
- 6.21** Following the conclusion of the promotion, the NMLA may retain the player's ENTRY information for marketing purposes.
- 6.22** All decisions by the NMLA are final.

7.0 PRE-DRAW PROCEDURES:

- 7.1** All ENTRIES for each drawing will be compiled onto a Master List by a designee from the MIS Division. The Master List will be put on a CD and given to the NMLA EVP of Security and Enforcement or designee.

- 7.1.1 The Master List will contain all ENTRIES for each specific drawing. The list will be sorted numerically.
- 7.1.2 The NMLA Internal Auditor or designee will verify the Master List.
- 7.2** The NMLA EVP of Security and Enforcement or designee shall provide to the NMLA Security Drawing representative or designee documentation with the following information:
 - 7.2.1 Promotion name
 - 7.2.2 Drawing date
 - 7.2.3 Number of ENTRIES (starting and ending range) as described in the NMLA Promotional Drawing Procedures.
 - 7.2.4 Number of winning ENTRIES and alternates to be selected

8.0 DRAWING PROCEDURES FOR THE 2ND CHANCE PRIZE DRAWINGS:

- 8.1** The pre-approved NMLA Promotional Drawing Procedures will be followed for each of the two (2) drawings.
- 8.2** The NMLA Security Drawing representative or designee will conduct each drawing.
- 8.3** The NMLA Internal Auditor or designee shall witness the drawing.
- 8.4** For each of the two (2) separate drawings, the Origin System will first select the five (5) prize winners from all ENTRIES received for that drawing.
- 8.5** For each separate drawing the Origin System will next select the ten (10) alternates from remaining ENTRIES received for that drawing.
- 8.6** The NMLA Security Drawing representative or designee will provide the list of selected winning ENTRIES and alternates to the NMLA EVP of Security and Enforcement.
- 8.7** The NMLA EVP of Security and Enforcement or designee will verify the selected ENTRIES and forward the list of winners to the Director of Marketing and Communications or designee.

9.0 WINNER NOTIFICATION:

- 9.1** An NMLA Marketing and Communications staff member will attempt to contact the apparent prize winner(s) by email or telephone within five (5) business days following the drawing to confirm the selected ticket ENTRY number with the apparent winner(s). Apparent winner(s) will be advised that they will be receiving official notification and instructions on how to claim their prize via certified mail or courier service within five (5) business days.
- 9.2** The official mailing will inform the winner that they must call or email the NMLA within 24 hours to confirm receipt of the letter and that they must present the original signed qualifying ticket and the completed NMLA prize claim form to the NMLA claim center within five (5) business days after receipt of said notification. NMLA prize claim form must include proof of identification.
 - 9.2.1 If the NMLA has not received the receipt of notification after five (5) business days, the NMLA will track the notification and allow fifteen (15) additional business days from the first attempt to deliver date for the winner to produce the original signed ticket and claim form. If the prize is not claimed by the end of the fifteenth (15th) business day the selected Entry will be disqualified and the alternate will be contacted in the order selected.
- 9.3** If the player's information entered via the Internet is incorrect and the NMLA cannot contact the player within the five (5) business days, the selected ENTRY will be disqualified and the alternate will be contacted in the order selected.
- 9.4** An NMLA Security and Enforcement representative will verify the original signed qualifying ticket to ensure the ENTRY meets all rules, as specified in all applicable NMLA Drawing Rules and Policies.
- 9.5** Upon verification of the original signed qualifying ticket and receipt of the completed NMLA claim form, the NMLA will make arrangements with the winner to receive their prize.
- 9.6** Apparent winners that fail to present the original signed qualifying ticket and completed NMLA prize claim form within the time frame described in Section 9.2 will forfeit their

right to any prize or consideration and notification will be made to the alternate ENTRY(s) in the order selected.

- 9.7 The alternate will be notified following the same process as outlined in this section. If necessary, this process will take place until all alternates have been contacted.
- 9.8 The prizes will go unclaimed if the selected winner and/or alternates are disqualified, cannot be contacted, or fail to comply with the above deadlines or requirements.

10.0 MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- 10.1 There is no cash value substitute for the prizes.
- 10.2 Winners will receive a W-2G tax form for the “fair market value” of any prize valued over six hundred dollars (\$600.00).
- 10.3 In the event that the NMLA removes this game from sale, these drawing rules will remain in effect unless changes are authorized by the CEO.
- 10.4 The NMLA reserves the right to perform background checks on 2nd Chance Prize Drawing winners and alternates.
- 10.5 The 2nd Chance Prize Drawing winner or alternates upon submitting an ENTRY agree that the NMLA may use their name, voice, photograph and/or likeness in any form for the purpose of advertising and/or publicizing the instant game SLINGO®, NMLA winners in general, or promoting the NMLA or any of its games.
- 10.6 The New Mexico Lottery Act, the NMLA General Drawing Rules and Procedures, and the NMLA Promotional Drawing Procedures shall apply to these drawings. In the event of a conflict between the Drawing Rules and Procedures for Game #636 SLINGO® 2nd Chance Drawing, NMLA General Drawing Rules, the NMLA Promotional Drawing Procedures and the New Mexico Lottery Act, the New Mexico Lottery Act shall prevail.
- 10.7 Copies of these rules are available at www.nmlottery.com or the NMLA claim center.
- 10.8 Prizes will not be awarded if the ticket was obtained contrary to any New Mexico State Statute and/or NMLA Policies and Procedures.
- 10.9 An ENTRY may not be submitted by the following:
 - 10.9.1 Any member of the NMLA Board
 - 10.9.2 Any officer or employee of the NMLA
 - 10.9.3 An owner, officer or employee of a lottery vendor or, in the case of a corporation, an owner of five percent or more of the corporate stock of a lottery vendor
 - 10.9.4 Anyone physically residing as a member of the same household in the principal place of residence of any such person.
